

Evidence of Insurability Forms

In-Scope Employees and Out of Scope Legacy Plan Employees who select benefits on Employee Self Serve:

If you have elected Life Insurance that requires medical evidence, the Evidence of Insurability form(s) will be mailed to your home address for completion.

Required forms must be completed by you and/or your dependents depending on the coverage you have requested.

For Life Insurance: Coverage is effective on the date the insurer provides approval, at which time premium deductions begin.

Out of Scope Employees enrolled in *Benefit*:

Please mail the original completed and signed form(s) to the insurer as instructed on the form.

For Life Insurance: Coverage is effective on the date the insurer provides approval, at which time premium deductions begin.

For Critical Illness Insurance: If approved, coverage is effective on the application date. Allocated Flex Credits pay the premiums.
