

HBTA Website - Employee Page

You can access your employee benefits information through the HBTA's Employee Information page specific to your employer.

The employee page is designed to be a single point of information for employees to access their HBTA benefit information. This page is accessed via direct link and may include important announcements, the most up to date employee benefit booklet(s), contact information, links, etc.

Your benefit plan is provided to support the health and financial well being of you and your family and is an important part of your overall compensation. Your participation in the Basic Life, AD&D and Disability plans is required if you occupy a benefits eligible position. You are also required to participate in Supplementary Health and Dental, with Family coverage selected if you have eligible dependents; however, you may opt out of these plans if proof of coverage under a spouse or other employer plan is provided. Alternatively, you may choose to coordinate your coverage under both plans. Details are provided in your Benefit Plan Booklet.
